WASHINGTON COUNTY PROCLAIMS SEPTEMBER 13-20 AS "IRONMAN® VOLUNTEER WEEK" AS THE EYES OF THE IRONMAN® WORLD NOW TURN TO THE ST. GEORGE AREA

Washington County, Utah (May 18, 2021) – On the heels of the area's most successful IRONMAN[®] race in its 11-year history, Washington County Commissioners issued a resolution proclaiming September 13-20 as "IRONMAN[®] Volunteer Week." This declaration comes as the the IRONMAN world

The proclamation also underscores the need for volunteers to support the IRONMAN[®] 70.3[®] World Championship and hopes to generate awareness to bring together local community members and businesses to support volunteer efforts during race week.

"The secret ingredient that makes this community shine so brightly is the spirit of service," said Kevin Lewis, Director for the Greater Zion Convention & Tourism Office. "Our residents are filled with a passion to help others succeed. It rises from our heritage, it runs through our veins and it spills out across the incredible events we host. It is held outside the United States for three consecutive years and then rotates back to the United States every fourth year. The race will take place Friday and Saturday, September 17-18, with females competing on Friday and males on Saturday. Washington County Schools will be closed on Friday, September 17, in support of the event.

"We are thrilled to host such a prestigious event and our hope is that this designation will formally recognize the incredible volunteer efforts that have benefited not only the community, but athletes from across the globe," said Commissioner Victor Iverson.

Commission Chair Gil Almquist added, "It is our hope that families and businesses in this community will welcome the world with open arms during race week and join hundreds of other volunteers to show the world what truly makes this community great."
