Expect road closures, delays and detours from 8:00 a.m. to 3:30 p.m.

How to get around

- To exit Ledges neighborhood and head North will be subject to delays but not closure.
- To exit Ledges neighborhood and head South residents will be directed onto Bluff Street, then U-turn to Snow Canyon Parkway then to 1400 West Street to Sunset Blvd.
- Returning to Ledges neighborhood will use Sunset Blvd to 1400 West to Snow Canyon to Bluff then North on SR-18

Athletes will be on course

• Athletes will be riding south on SR-18 from 9:00 a.m. to 3:00 p.m. using both southbound lanes.
