On Saturday, September 18, 2021, the Greater Zion Convention & Tourism Office and The IRONMAN Group will welcome nearly 4,000 world class athletes (and their support teams) for the 2021 Intermountain Healthcare IRONMAN 70.3 World Championship presented by Utah Sports Commission. This epic triathlon (swim, bike and run) starts at beautiful Sand Hollow State Park and finishes in downtown St. George, traversing 70.3 miles across Hurricane, Washington City, Ivins and Snow Canyon State Park.

This letter provides specific information for your neighborhood to help residents adjust plans to accommodate the race and to minimize impacts to your day.

IN YOUR NEIGHBORHOOD ...

Expect road closures, delays and detours from 6:30 a.m. to 12:15 p.m.

- SR9 / State Street will be impacted between SR7 Inter-change and Telegraph Street
- SR7/ Southern Parkway will be closed in both directions from State Street to Sand Hollow Road

How to get around

- Access to Hurricane is best by using 600 North and avoiding SR9 / State Street
- Access to I-15 is via SR9 / State Street using the traffic control and subject to delays
- Quail Lake Estate Rd. will be closed, access only via 4400 West

Athletes will be on course

- Athletes will be riding south on SR9 / State Street from 7:50 a.m. to 12:15 p.m. using both westbound lanes.
