TRAFFIC IMPACTS COMING

WHAT:



On Saturday, September 18, 2021, the Greater Zion Convention & Tourism Office and The IRONMAN Group will welcome nearly 4,000 world class athletes (and their support teams) for the 2021 Intermountain Healthcare IRONMAN 70.3 World Championship presented by Utah Sports Commission. This epic triathlon (swim, bike and run) starts at beautiful Sand Hollow State Park and finishes in downtown St. George, traversing 70.3 miles across Hurricane, Washington City, Ivins and Snow Canyon State Park.

This letter provides specific information for your neighborhood to help residents adjust plans to accommodate the race and to minimize impacts to your day.

IN YOUR NEIGHBORHOOD ...

Expect road closures, delays and detours from 8:00 a.m. to 3:30 p.m.

- SR 18 will be subject to delays and detours when athletes are on course.

How to get around

- To avoid event impacts suggested car traffic alternate routes are Gunlock Drive out of Veyo OR SR 56 into Cedar City then south on I-15
- All southbound truck traffic should use SR 56 to Cedar City then South on I-15 during the event window.
- All southbound traffic into St. George will be directed onto Snow Canyon Parkway (after the Bluff Street flyover) and directed to use 1400 West to Sunset to access Bluff once again.
- Northbound SR 18 out of St. George will be accessible via Sunset to 1400 West to Snow Canyon Parkway to Bluff to SR 18 North.
- From Las Vegas, take Hwy 93 north to Panaca, then use Hwy 56 to Beryl Junction/Enterprise.
- From Enterprise/Beryl Junction, use Hwy 56 west to Panaca, then take Hwy 93 South to I-15.

Athletes will be on course

- Athletes will be riding south on SR-18 from 9:00 a.m. to 3:00 p.m. using both southbound lanes.
