## TRAFFIC IMPACTS COMING

**WHERE:** Sand Hollow Road & Dixie Springs Area, Hurricane City

On Saturday, September 18, 2021, the Greater Zion Convention & Tourism Office and The IRONMAN Group will welcome nearly 4,000 world class athletes (and their support teams) for the 2021 Intermountain Healthcare IRONMAN 70.3 World Championship presented by Utah Sports Commission. This epic triathlon (swim, bike and run) starts at beautiful Sand Hollow State Park and finishes in downtown St. George, traversing 70.3 miles across Hurricane, Washington City, Ivins and Snow Canyon State Park.

**This letter provides specific information for your neighborhood** to help residents adjust plans to accommodate the race and to minimize impacts to your day.

### IN YOUR NEIGHBORHOOD ...

**Expect road closures and detours from 6:30 a.m. to 12:15 p.m.**

- SR7 / Southern Parkway will be closed in both directions from Sand Hollow Road to SR9 / State Street
- Sand Hollow Road & SR9 / State Street intersection will be closed from approximately 6:30 a.m. to 12:15 p.m.

#### How to get around

- To exit Sand Hollow Road area use SR7 / Southern Parkway WEST to Washington Dam Road or further West
- To return home during the event window use SR7/ Southern Parkway EAST exit at Sand Hollow Road only LOCAL residential traffic will be allowed past Washington Dam Road.

#### Athletes will be on course

- Athletes will be riding on Sand Hollow Road from the Park Entrance to SR7 / Southern Parkway from 7:20 a.m. to 11:00 a.m.
- Athletes will be riding on SR9 / State Street from 7:50 a.m. to 12:15 p.m.
