On Saturday, September 18, 2021, the Greater Zion Convention & Tourism Office and The IRONMAN Group will welcome nearly 4,000 world class athletes (and their support teams) for the 2021 Intermountain Healthcare IRONMAN 70.3 World Championship presented by Utah Sports Commission. This epic triathlon (swim, bike and run) starts at beautiful Sand Hollow State Park and finishes in downtown St. George, traversing 70.3 miles across Hurricane, Washington City, Ivins and Snow Canyon State Park.

This letter provides specific information for your neighborhood to help residents adjust plans to accommodate the race and to minimize impacts to your day.

IN YOUR NEIGHBORHOOD ...

Expect road closures, delays and detours from 7:00 a.m. to 12:45 p.m.

- There will be no access to SR9 / State Street from Telegraph

How to get around

- Coral Canyon Residents are encouraged to exit via Coral Canyon Blvd to State Street / SR9 to avoid delays
- All Residents will be directed WEST on Telegraph to exit their neighborhood. Return is limited to local traffic only
- Highland Parkway Residents will exit WEST toward Washington City Only, returning traffic will turn right onto Highland Parkway then directed to cross athletes. No left turns from Telegraph onto Highland will be allowed.

Athletes will be on course

- Athletes will be riding WEST on Telegraph Street from 8:00 a.m. to 12:25 p.m. using both westbound lanes.
