On Saturday, May 7, 2022, the Greater Zion Convention & Tourism Office and The IRONMAN Group will welcome nearly 3500 world-class athletes (and their support teams) for the Intermountain Healthcare IRONMAN World Championship presented by the Utah Sports Commission. This epic triathlon (swim, bike and run) starts at beautiful Sand Hollow State Park and finishes in downtown St. George, traversing 140.6 miles across Hurricane, Washington City, Ivins, Gunlock, Veyo and Snow Canyon State Park.

This letter provides specific information for your neighborhood to help residents adjust plans to accommodate the race and to minimize impacts to your day.

IN YOUR NEIGHBORHOOD ...

Expect road closures and detours from 3 a.m. to 3 p.m.

- SR7 closed in both directions from Warner Valley Road to the State Street/SR9 interchange
- 3000 South will be closed at 1100 West to all but residential traffic

How to get around

- Residential traffic will be allowed on 3000 South from 1100 West when athletes are on course; no access from SR7

Athletes will be on course

- Athletes will be riding on SR7 from 7 a.m. - 12:30 p.m.
