On Saturday, May 7, 2022, the Greater Zion Convention & Tourism Office and The IRONMAN Group will welcome nearly 3500 world class athletes (and their support teams) for the 2021 Intermountain Healthcare IRONMAN World Championship presented by Utah Sports Commission. IN YOUR NEIGHBORHOOD ...

Expect road closures, delays and detours from 9 a.m. to 2 a.m. (May 8)

Dixie Drive will be impacted and subject to delays.

How to get around

- Access out of neighborhoods along the west side of Dixie Drive will be able to go north and south in the contraflow lanes between Sunset Blvd and Alienta Drive.
- Access in and out of neighborhoods along the east side of Dixie Drive will be directed to use Valley View Drive to exit the area.
- Return access will be via Valley View or Dixie Drive.

Athletes will be running on Dixie Drive from 11:45 a.m. to 12 Midnight (May 8) using both northbound lanes.
