TRAFFIC IMPACTS COMING

WHERE: Ledges Neighborhood, City of St. George

WHEN: Saturday, May 7, 2022

WHAT:



On Saturday, May 7, 2022, the Greater Zion Convention & Tourism Office and The IRONMAN Group will welcome nearly 3500 world-class athletes (and their support teams) for the Intermountain Healthcare IRONMAN World Championship presented by the Utah Sports Commission. This epic triathlon (swim, bike and run) starts at beautiful Sand Hollow State Park and finishes in downtown St. George, traversing 140.6 miles across Hurricane, Washington City, Ivins, Gunlock, Veyo and Snow Canyon State Park.

This letter provides specific information for your neighborhood to help residents adjust plans to accommodate the race and to minimize impacts to your day.

IN YOUR NEIGHBORHOOD ...

Expect road closures, delays and detours from 8 a.m. to 7 p.m.

- SR18 will be subject to delays and detours when athletes are on course.

How to get around

- Exiting the Ledges neighborhood to head North will be subject to delays, but not closure.
- To exit the Ledges neighborhood and head South, residents will be directed/metered onto SR18 and will be able to proceed South to Sunset/Bluff.
- Returning to the Ledges neighborhood from St. George, use Sunset Blvd to 1400 West to Snow Canyon Parkway East to Bluff where there is a detour to go North on SR18. Expect delays.
- Returning to the Ledges neighborhood from the North, use 5745 North.

Athletes will be on course

- Athletes will be riding south on SR18 from 10 a.m. to 6:30 p.m. using one southbound lane.
