## TRAFFIC IMPACTS COMING

**WHERE:** North State Street Residential Area, City of Hurricane

**WHEN:** Saturday, May 7, 2022

**WHAT:**



On Saturday, May 7, 2022, the Greater Zion Convention & Tourism Office and The IRONMAN Group will welcome nearly 3500 world-class athletes (and their support teams) for the Intermountain Healthcare IRONMAN World Championship presented by the Utah Sports Commission. This epic triathlon (swim, bike and run) starts at beautiful Sand Hollow State Park and finishes in downtown St. George, traversing 140.6 miles across Hurricane, Washington City, Ivins, Gunlock, Veyo and Snow Canyon State Park.

This letter provides specific information for your neighborhood to help residents adjust plans to accommodate the race and to minimize impacts to your day.

### IN YOUR NEIGHBORHOOD ...

#### Expect road closures, delays and detours from 3 a.m. to 3 p.m.

- SR9 / State Street will be impacted between the SR7 interchange and Telegraph Street
- SR7/ Southern Parkway will be closed in both directions from State Street to Warner Valley Road
- SR9 will be limited to two-way traffic using westbound lanes

#### How to get around

- Access to Hurricane is best by using 600 North and avoiding SR9 / State Street
- Access to I-15 via SR9 / State Street is via single lane; expect delays
- Quail Lake Estate Rd. will be closed, access only via 4400 West

#### Athletes will be on course

- Athletes will be riding south on SR9 / State Street from 7:45 a.m. to 1:15 p.m. using both eastbound lanes.
