On Friday **AND** Saturday, October 28 and 29, 2022, the Greater Zion Convention & Tourism Office and The IRONMAN Group will welcome nearly 6,000 world-class athletes (and their support teams) for the 2022 Intermountain Healthcare IRONMAN 70.3 World Championship presented by Utah Sports Commission. This world championship triathlon (swim, bike and run) starts at beautiful Sand Hollow State Park and finishes in downtown St. George, traversing 70.3 miles across Hurricane, Washington City, Ivins, and Snow Canyon State Park.

This letter provides specific information for your neighborhood to help residents adjust plans to accommodate the race and to minimize impacts to your days.

## IN YOUR NEIGHBORHOOD ...

Expect road closures, delays and detours from 7:45am to 3:30 pm

• Snow Canyon Parkway will be impacted and subject to delays

### How to get around

- Access out of neighborhoods above Snow Canyon Parkway will be from specific access points: N. Great Basin Drive, Lakota Drive, Entrada Trail and The Cliffs ONLY subject to right turns only
- When returning home, use Dixie Downs Rd and then Snow Canyon Westbound to access Snow Canyon Parkway
- Access in and out of Split Rock and Red Mountain Circle will be managed through a controlled access lane
- Access out of Snow Canyon Drive will be WEST on Tuacahn Drive, to E Citadel Dr, then to Painted Hills Dr S to Center Street and be metered down to North Park Avenue Way and up to 200 N and west to Kwavasa Dr

### Athletes will be on course

Athletes will be riding WEST on Snow Canyon Parkway from 9:00a m to 2:00 pm using both westbound lanes
