WHAT:



On Saturday, May 6, the Greater Zion Convention & Tourism Office and The IRONMAN Group will welcome nearly 2,500 athletes (and their support teams) for the 2023 Intermountain Health IRONMAN 70.3 North American Championship. This triathlon (swim, bike and run) starts at beautiful Sand Hollow State Park and finishes in downtown St. George, traversing 70.3 miles across Hurricane, Washington City, Ivins, and Snow Canyon State Park.

This letter provides specific information for your neighborhood to help residents adjust plans to accommodate the race and to minimize impacts to your days.

IN YOUR NEIGHBORHOOD ...

Expect road closures and detours from 6:00 am to 6:00 pm

- Diagonal Street will be closed to traffic in both directions
- No Access to Bluff Street or Main Street will be allowed when athletes are on course

How to get around

- When athletes are on course, there will be an access lane along Diagonal to allow residents to access 500 North
- To exit, take Hope Street to Main Street and exit the area at 200 East
- To return to the neighborhood before 6:30 pm, use 200 East at St George BLVD to access Diagonal Street
