TRAFFIC IMPACTS COMING

WHERE: 3700 West & Sand Hollow Road, Dixie Springs Area

WHEN: Saturday, May 4, 2024

WHAT:



On Saturday, May 4, the Greater Zion Convention & Tourism Office and The IRONMAN Group will welcome nearly 2,500 athletes (and their support teams) for the 2024 Intermountain Health IRONMAN 70.3 North American Championship. This triathlon (swim, bike and run) starts at beautiful Sand Hollow State Park and finishes in downtown St. George, traversing 70.3 miles across Hurricane, Washington City, Ivins, and Snow Canyon State Park.

This letter provides specific information for your neighborhood to help residents adjust plans to accommodate the race and to minimize impacts to your days.

IN YOUR NEIGHBORHOOD ...

Expect delays and detours from 3 am to 1:00 pm

- SR7 / Southern Parkway will be closed NORTHBOUND from Sand Hollow Road to SR9 / State Street.
- SR7/Southern Parkway will be open SOUTHBOUND from Sand Hollow Road or the SR9 interchange.
- Sand Hollow Road & SR7 – local traffic can access SR7 from Sand Hollow Road and Head South ONLY on SR7
- Sand Hollow Road & SR9 / State Street intersection will be open to a RIGHT TURN ONLY onto SR9; vehicles will detour to the SR7 interchange and will go up and over the overpass to go East or West on SR9.
- Prior to approximately 6:30 am a left turn will be permitted from Sand Hollow Rd onto West SR9. After this time a forced right turn at this intersection will be implemented.

How to get around

- Local traffic ONLY - To exit Sand Hollow Road area, use Sand Hollow Road to SR7 (AVOID SR9 if possible); make a right turn onto SR7 and follow the route.
- To return home during the event window, use SR7/ Southern Parkway EAST, and exit at Sand Hollow Road only.
