on Saturday, May 4, the Greater Zion Convention & Tourism Office and The IRONMAN Group will welcome nearly 2,500 athletes (and their support teams) for the 2024 Intermountain Health IRONMAN 70.3 North American Championship. This triathlon (swim, bike and run) starts at beautiful Sand Hollow State Park and finishes in downtown St. George, traversing 70.3 miles across Hurricane, Washington City, Ivins, and Snow Canyon State Park.

This letter provides specific information for your neighborhood to help residents adjust plans to accommodate the race and to minimize impacts to your days.

IN YOUR NEIGHBORHOOD:

Expect road closures and detours all day Friday, May 3, 2024

- Main Street from East Tabernacle to 100 South will be closed.
- Tabernacle from 200 West to Main Street will be closed.

Expect road closures and detours from 6:00 AM to 7:00 PM SATURDAY May 4, 2024

- Main Street from Diagonal to 100 S will be closed.
- Tabernacle from 200 West to 200 E will be closed.
- St. George Blvd from 100 West to 100 East will be closed.

How to get around

- Residential traffic traveling on St. George Blvd heading West toward Bluff St should use the detour routes
 provided at 400 East or 700 East to travel southbound. The detours will then utilize 100 South, 300 South and
 700 South to travel westbound towards Bluff Street.
- Residential traffic from Bluff St heading East should use either 700 South or the Bluff Street access to I-15.
- St. George Blvd will be closed to thru traffic at Main Street. However, access to St. George Blvd businesses is available. Businesses east of Main Street are best accessed from Red Hills Parkway using Skyline Dr or accessing St. George Blvd from the south at 400 East. Businesses west of Main Street are best accessed from Bluff Street.
