On Saturday, May 4, the Greater Zion Convention & Tourism Office and The IRONMAN Group will welcome nearly 2,500 athletes (and their support teams) for the 2024 Intermountain Health IRONMAN 70.3 North American Championship. This triathlon (swim, bike and run) starts at beautiful Sand Hollow State Park and finishes in downtown St. George, traversing 70.3 miles across Hurricane, Washington City, Ivins, and Snow Canyon State Park.

This letter provides specific information for your neighborhood to help residents adjust plans to accommodate the race and to minimize impacts to your days.

IN YOUR NEIGHBORHOOD ...

Expect road closures, delays, and detours from 5:00 AM to 3:00 PM.

• Red Hills Parkway westbound lanes will be reduced to a single lane for vehicle traffic. Expect slower speeds and possible delays in this area.

How to get around

- Access into and out of neighborhoods above Red Hills Parkway will be from specific access points that will be monitored by police officers: 1400 East, Cottonwood Springs Road, and 1800 East.
- Residential traffic will be subject to delays when crossing athletes on Red Hills Parkway. Obey officers.
- Red Hills Parkway eastbound lanes will be open to vehicular traffic. The westbound lanes will be restricted to a single lane of travel; expect delays. Two-way vehicle traffic on race day; expect delays.
