## TRAFFIC IMPACTS COMING

WHERE: Green Springs & Washington Parkway Neighborhoods, Washington City WHEN: Saturday, May 10, 2025 WHAT:



On Saturday, May 10, the Greater Zion Convention & Tourism Office and The IRONMAN Group will welcome nearly 2,500 athletes (and their support teams) for the 2025 Intermountain Health IRONMAN 70.3 North American Championship. This triathlon (swim, bike and run) starts at beautiful Sand Hollow State Park and finishes in downtown St. George, traversing 70.3 miles across Hurricane, Washington City, Ivins, and Snow Canyon State Park.

This letter provides specific information for your neighborhood to help residents adjust plans to accommodate the race and to minimize impacts to your days.

#### IN YOUR NEIGHBORHOOD ...

#### Expect road closures, delays, and detours from 5:00 am to 3:00 pm

- North of Red Mesa Dr. both SOUTHBOUND lanes closest to the curb on Green Spring Drive will be closed and for athletes only.
- Washington Parkway will be closed from I-15 to N Green Spring in both directions.

#### How to get around

- All residents will be able to exit and enter via Green Spring at designated locations; subject to delays when athletes are on course.
- The designated locations are Wiltshire Street, Concord Parkway, Red Bluff Circle, Green Spring Heights, Vista View Drive, West Cove Drive and West Hill View.
- All access roads on the east side of Green Springs Dr will be open.
- All access roads on the west side of Green Springs Drive should expect delays except for the following which will be closed: W Wiltshire Dr, Great Falls Dr, Red Bluff Dr, Green Springs Heights, and Shadow Ridge.
