On Saturday, May 10, the Greater Zion Convention & Tourism Office and The IRONMAN Group will welcome nearly 2,500 athletes (and their support teams) for the 2025 Intermountain Health IRONMAN 70.3 North American Championship. This triathlon (swim, bike and run) starts at beautiful Sand Hollow State Park and finishes in downtown St. George, traversing 70.3 miles across Hurricane, Washington City, Ivins, and Snow Canyon State Park.

This letter provides specific information for your neighborhood to help residents adjust plans to accommodate the race and to minimize impacts to your days.

## IN YOUR BUSINESS NEIGHBORHOOD ...

### Expect road closures and detours from 6:30 AM to 12:00 PM

- 5300 W & SR9 / State Street intersection will be closed when athletes are on SR9/ State Street.
- Eastbound and Westbound vehicle traffic will be allowed on SR9 in the Westbound Lanes; no access to the Fairgrounds portion of 5300 W will be allowed when athletes are on course.

### How to get around

- For access to businesses after approximately 6:30 am on Saturday, use Telegraph St. to Landfill Road to Regional Park Road.
- No access to Telegraph from SR9; suggested route is via I-15 to the Main Street Exit 12.
- Expect some delays along Telegraph Street, as it's part of the bike course.
