On Saturday, May 10, the Greater Zion Convention & Tourism Office and The IRONMAN Group will welcome nearly 2,500 athletes (and their support teams) for the 2025 Intermountain Health IRONMAN 70.3 North American Championship. This triathlon (swim, bike and run) starts at beautiful Sand Hollow State Park and finishes in downtown St. George, traversing 70.3 miles across Hurricane, Washington City, Ivins, and Snow Canyon State Park.

# IN YOUR NEIGHBORHOOD ...

#### Expect road closures, delays and detours from 3:00 am to 1:00 pm

- SR9 / State Street will be impacted between the SR7 interchange and Telegraph Street
- SR7/ Southern Parkway SOUTHBOUND will be open from SR9
- SR7/ Southern Parkway NORTHBOUND will be closed at Sand Hollow Road to SR9

# How to get around

- SR9 will be open to EB & WB traffic all day- expect delays.
- Access to I-15 via SR9 / State Street is open using traffic control and subject to delays
- Quail Lake Estate Road will be closed, access only via 4400 West (Quail Lake Estates West Entrance)
