On Saturday, May 10, the Greater Zion Convention & Tourism Office and The IRONMAN Group will welcome nearly 2,500 athletes (and their support teams) for the 2025 Intermountain Health IRONMAN 70.3 North American Championship. This triathlon (swim, bike and run) starts at beautiful Sand Hollow State Park and finishes in downtown St. George, traversing 70.3 miles across Hurricane, Washington City, Ivins, and Snow Canyon State Park.

This letter provides specific information for your neighborhood to help residents adjust plans to accommodate the race and to minimize impacts to your days.

IN YOUR NEIGHBORHOOD ...

Expect road closures, delays, and detours from 6:00 AM to 4:00 PM.

- Traffic will be allowed NB and SB on SR18; expect delays when athletes are on course.
- SR18 southbound traffic will proceed southbound to the Sunset Blvd/Bluff Street intersection. Access from SR18 to Red Hills and Snow Canyon Parkway will not be permitted.

How to get around

 Returning to Veyo and the Veyo area from St. George, use Sunset Blvd to 1400 West, east on Snow Canyon Parkway, turn South onto Bluff Street. Use the provided U-turn on Bluff Street to then travel north on SR18; expect delays.
